<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God will protect you from the evil one</li> <li>- Mt 6:9-13 - don't lead us into temptation but deliver us from the evil one (James 1:13-14 - Satan leads us into temptation through the lust of our flesh)</li> <li>- Eph 6:10-18 - put on the full armor of God</li> <li>- Truth versus lies of Satan (Jn 8:23, 40, 42-44; 17:14-22)</li> <li>- I Peter 5:8-11 - predatory nature of Satan</li> </ul>	<p>I Thes 4:9-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- lead a quiet life</li> <li>- Attend to your own business</li> <li>- Work with your hands</li> <li>- Behave properly</li> <li>- Don't be in any need</li> </ul> <p>II Thes 3:6-15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- keep away from those who are undisciplined</li> <li>- Follow my example (disciplined, providing for themselves, working hard, not a burden to others (I Thes 2:5-12; I Cor 9:9-15))</li> <li>- If you don't work, you don't eat</li> <li>- Don't busybodies</li> <li>- Work in a quiet fashion - eat your own food</li> <li>- Don't grow weary of doing good</li> <li>- Don't associate with those who won't obey these instructions (I Cor 15:33)</li> <li>- Admonish him as a brother</li> </ul> <p>I Tim 5:3-8 - the one who doesn't care for his family had denied the faith and worse than an unbeliever</p>	<p>I Thes 3:11-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God causes you to increase and abound in love for one another</li> <li>- This establishes your heart without blame in holiness (I John)</li> </ul> <p>II Thes 1:3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- love grows greater</li> </ul> <p>I Thes 5:15, 23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- don't pay back evil for evil</li> <li>- Seek that which is good for one another</li> <li>- God is setting you apart from the rest of the world</li> </ul> <p>I Cor 13:4-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- the characteristics of love</li> </ul>
