<p>1-8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - keep the commandments - When you cross into good land - set up stones coated in lime on Mt Ebal - by Shechem (Gen 12:6-7) - center of the land - Build an altar - uncut stones and offer burnt offerings there and peace offerings (Ex 24:1-8) - Write distinctly, clearly <p>9-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - listen, obey, and do His commandments <p>11-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - divide into 2 groups - 6 tribes on each mountain <p>15-26 - Cursings for</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Idolatry - Ill-treatment of parents - Moving boundary markers - Misleading the blind - Distorting justice for the poor - Sleeping with father's wife - Bestiality - Incest - Sleeps with mother-in-law - attack neighbor - Takes bribes to attack innocent person - For those who don't do the words of the law - total obedience (II Cor 5:21) 	<p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - diligently obey the Lord - Blesses everything - children, animals, produce, life - if they obey <p>7-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - enemies will be defeated - Establish them above the nations - The nations will see you and be afraid - They will be leaders in the world IF they follow God <p>15-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all of life will be cursed if they don't follow Him <p>20-26</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they will be consumed from within and from their enemies without - God will withhold the rains - You have forsaken Him <p>27-44</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - physical plagues - What you have will be taken (20:5-7) - Boils from the soles of the feet to the crown of the head (Job 2:7) - You will lose all the produce of your ground - you will be the borrower - not the lender <p>45-68</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - curses will overtake you - You didn't serve the Lord - Besieging and eating your own children 	<p>1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - covenant at Moab that extends the covenant at Horeb - Pointing to the need for a different covenant - a new covenant (29:4; 30:6 - God will take care of their heart - Jer 31:31-34; Ez 36:26-27 - a new covenant) <p>2-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - you have seen what the Lord has done - Yet - you do not see, hear, or know God - Romans 11 <p>10-13</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - you are all standing here today to make a covenant with the Lord - inward devotion - heart and life - He wants to establish His people <p>14-21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the covenant was made for them and the future generations - They as a nation would lead all nations to salvation (Gen 12:3; 18:18; 22:18; 26:4) - Jn 17:20-21; Acts 2:39 - Warning - don't turn aside to idols <p>22-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - there is obvious punishment by God for turning away from Him - If they abandon the Lord - it is not an "if" it is a "when" - We see enough around us to know the way we should walk in obedience to Him 	<p>Promised Restoration</p> <p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the blessing and cursing will come upon them - When they are scattered they will remember what God has done - They will return to the land and God will prosper them <p>6-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the Lord will circumcise their heart - and they will love Him - True salvation - If you love the Lord you will walk in His ways <p>11-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - His commandments are not difficult - Love the Lord and your neighbor <p>15-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 choices - Love and obey God = life and prosperity - Reject God = death and adversity - Jn 3:1-36
