<p>Phil 4:4-7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rejoice in the Lord (cf Phil 1:6) - Let your gentle spirit be known to all men - Be anxious for nothing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Trust God for everything! Anxiety is the opposite of trust - with prayer and supplication let your requests be made known to God <p>Result - peace of God which surpasses all comprehension will guard your hearts and minds!</p> <p>Verses for anxiety</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ps 55:22 - casting burdens on Him - He will not allow us to be shaken or our feet to slip - Ps 37:5 - commit your way to the Lord - Is 26:3 - those commit themselves to the Lord will be kept in perfect and constant peace - Is 41:10; 43:1-2 - don't fear - God is with us - He is our protector - Mt 6:24-34 - God cares for all the little things in life - seek His kingdom first - I Peter 5:7 - cast your anxiety on Him for He cares for you 	<p>II Chronicles 20 - Jehoshaphat</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - problem came - he went to the Lord (3) - Pray (6-12) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Acknowledges His power Acknowledges the Covenant Claims the promises that God has made God you judge them Acknowledge their helplessness Our eyes are on You - God's response <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Don't be afraid The battle is the Lord's Face the enemy but don't fight or fear Is Lord is with you Worshipped the Lord Gave thanks to the Lord - His love is everlasting They sang and gave praise to the Lord The enemy turned on each other Acknowledge the Lord's victory 	<p>Think on these things and the God of peace will be with you (Phil 4:8-9)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - think = present imperative active - True (unconcealed in character; God's Word) - Honorable (dignified, worth much, worthy of respect, virtuous) - Right (in God's eyes, God's standards) - Pure (undefiled, free from ceremonial defilement, holy) - Lovely (pleasing in God's eyes, peaceful, acceptable to God) - Good repute (reputable, well spoken of, trusted) - Excellence (moral goodness, tremendous worth in God's eyes) - Praise (praise reserved for God) <p>Why?</p> <p>Prov 4:23 - out of our heart flows life Prov 23:7 - as a man thinks so he is Matt 15:18-20 - out of the mouth will come things from the heart I Cor 2:16 - the Holy Spirit will give us Christ's mind and instruct us of what is good and pure</p> <p>II Cor 10:3-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - warfare is in the mind against the devil - Have powerful weapons for the destruction of fortresses in our minds - Eph 6:10-17 - Phil 4:8 - think on these to fill your mind
