<p>Righteousness is manifested apart from the Law (21)</p> <p>Is for all who believe - there is no distinction (22)</p> <p>All have sinned (23)</p> <p>Justified as a gift by faith through the <u>redemption</u> in Jesus Christ (24)</p> <p>God displayed Jesus as a <u>propitiation</u> in His blood through faith (25)</p> <p>Man is <u>justified</u> by faith apart from works of the Law (28)</p> <p>The Law is not nullified, but it is established by faith (31)</p> <p>Abraham believed God, <u>reckoned/credited/imputed</u> to him as righteousness (4:3)</p>	<p>AGORAZO = to buy in the market I Cor 6:20 - you have been bought with a price therefore glorify God in your body I Cor 7:23 - you have been bought with a price - don't become slaves of men Don't serve men - serve God! Rev 5:9 - purchased men with His blood EXAGORAZO = to buy out of, to redeem from Gal 3:13 - redeemed by Christ from the curse of the Law Gal 4:5 - redeemed to receive adoption as sons LUTROO = to release by paying a price Titus 2:14 - redeemed us from lawless deeds &amp; purified us for good deeds I Peter 1:18-19 - redeemed not with silver and gold but the blood of Christ - from our futile way of life APOLUTROSIS = deliverance from the guilt of sin; to release on receipt of ransom I Cor 1:30 - Jesus became redemption to us Ro 8:23</p>	<p>HILASTERION = <b>satisfaction</b>; Jesus became the Mercy Seat for His people &amp; also the means of that mercy Heb 2:17 - Jesus became High Priest to make propitiation for the sins of the people HILASKOMAI = as victim &amp; High Priest He <b>satisfied</b> the justice of God I John 2:2 - He is the propitiation for our sins &amp; the sins of the whole world</p> <p>Propitiation makes possible the taking away sins without violating God's holiness</p> <p>HILASMOS = refers to Christ who not only propitiates, but offers Himself as the propitiatory sacrifice</p> <p>Christ <b>satisfies</b> God's righteousness &amp; judgment I John 4:10 - God sent Jesus to be the propitiation for our sins</p>	<p>Dikaioo - declared righteous Rom 3:20 - by the works of the Law, no flesh will be justified in His sight Rom 3:22-24 - all have sinned; justified as a gift by His grace through redemption Rom 3:30 - justified by faith Gal 2:16 - not justified by works of Law but by faith Gal 3:8 - God would justify the Gentiles by faith Gal 3:24 - Law was our tutor - lead us to Christ - we could justified by faith</p> <p>DIKAIOSIS - the act of pronouncing righteous</p> <p>Ro 4:25 - raised for our justification</p> <p>Rom 5:1 - having been justified by faith, we have peace with God</p> <p>God declares us justified because our righteousness which is imputed to us by our faith in the redeeming sacrifice of Christ which is our propitiation</p>	<p>LOGIZOMAI - to reckon, to put to one's account</p> <p>Rom 4:6 - God credits righteousness - apart from works</p> <p>Rom 4:8 - blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will not take into account</p> <p>Rom 4:11 - righteousness was reckoned to those who believe</p> <p>Rom 4:22-24 - righteousness reckoned to those who believe</p> <p>II Cor 5:19 - God in Christ reconciled the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them</p> <p>James 2:23 - Abraham believed God - reckoned to him as righteousness</p>
