<p>4:31 - we are not children of the bondwoman - not slaves</p> <p>5:1 - Christ set us free - don't be burdened by or oppressed by the law (man-made religion)</p> <p>5:13 don't turn your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh</p> <p>we cannot just live and do whatever we want</p> <p>Jude 4 - ungodly men who turn the grace of God into licentiousness (license to sin) - deny our only Master and Lord</p> <p>free not to fill selfish desires - free from the burden of sin so we can serve God and others</p> <p>we become His bondservant</p>	<p>Gen 17 - sign of circumcision - sign of the promise that God gave to Abraham</p> <p>circumcision - cutting away of flesh of the foreskin</p> <p>Gal 5:2-3 - circumcision isn't merit before God - if that had the ability to save - the Christ does you no good - now you would need to keep the whole law</p> <p>Gal 5:6 - circumcision is meaningless when it comes to salvation</p> <p>Gal 5:10-12 - during this time there was a cult called the Cybele - priests were self-made eunuchs mutilate = castrate</p> <p>makes the point that self mutilation doesn't make you more righteous</p> <p>Gal 6:12-15 - the desire was to boast about how many they had following them</p>	<p>Gal 1:6, 15 - we are called through grace</p> <p>Gal 2:9, 21 - grace is given through God and we minister through the grace God has given us</p> <p>Eph 2:8-10 - grace that saved us - grace is a gift from God</p> <p>Grace = gift that we receive that gives us salvation, a call, and a ministry</p> <p>it comes through faith in Christ Jesus and what He did on our behalf</p> <p>Gal 5:4 faith needs to be placed in the right place</p> <p>this wasn't genuine faith</p> <p>faith is proven by being faithful to the end</p> <p>Matt 13:3-30</p>	<p>Gal 5:5 - waiting for the hope of righteousness</p> <p>II Cor 5:21 - Jesus knew no sin but was made sin on our behalf so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him</p> <p>Eph 4:24 - put on the new self - is in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness (Ro 12:1-2)</p> <p>I Peter 2:24 - die to sin and live to righteousness</p> <p>Is 61:10 - God clothed me in salvation and wrapped me with a robe of righteousness</p>
