| <p>1. Who has bewitched you?</p> <p>2. Did you receive the Spirit by works or by faith?</p> <p>3. Are you so foolish?</p> <p>4. If you started by the Spirit are you perfected in the flesh?</p> <p>5. Did you suffer in vain?</p> <p>6. Does God who gives you the Spirit and works miracles in you, do it by works of the Law or by faith?</p> | <p>his faith was reckoned as righteousness (6)</p> <p>The Scripture preached the gospel to Abraham (8) - all the nations will be blessed in you</p> <p>Abraham is called the believer (9)</p> <p>Jesus Christ was the blessing that would come through Abraham to the Gentiles (14)</p> <p>The promised seed was Christ (16)</p> <p>God gave a promise to Abraham that all the nations would be blessed (18)</p> <p>the Law was there for a time until Jesus came (19)</p> | <p>Jesus was portrayed as publicly crucified (1)</p> <p>He redeemed us from the curse of the law (13)</p> <p>Jesus took the curse from us</p> <p>He is the blessing to the Gentiles (and Jews) (14)</p> <p>His coming took the place of the Law (19)</p> <p>Jesus was the promise that would break the bonds of sin (22)</p> <p>Christ justifies us through faith (24)</p> <p>we have been baptized with Him and clothed with Him (27)</p> <p>We are all one in Christ (28)</p> <p>if we belong to Christ we are heirs of promise (29)</p> | <p>to try to live by the law is under a curse - you'll never be able to live up to it</p> <p>EVIDENT that no one is justified by the Law but by faith</p> <p>Jesus died so we could receive the promise of the Spirit through faith</p> <p>Law</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - tutor to lead us to Christ (3:24) - Rom 1:16-17 - does point to the way of salvation (Hab 2:4) - Rom 3:20 - through the Law comes knowledge of sin - Heb 9:15-10:22 - Law is a shadow of the good that was to come; Law pointed to the substance of Jesus - the blood of bulls and goats were used until the blood of Jesus was shed |

| <p>Promise</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - promise was spoken to Abraham and to his seed - seed = Jesus - the covenant that came 430 years later did not nullify the promise made to Abraham (Abrahamic Covenant) - God granted Abraham a promise that was not based on law | <p>Gen 12, 15, 17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - father of many nations - land (promised) - many descendant - seed - through you all the nations of the earth will be blessed - blessings (curses) - name was changed - son Isaac - they would be slaves for 400 years - plunder that nation <p>Isaac - Gen 26:1-5 Jacob - Gen 28:10-14 Jacob = Israel (Gen 32:28) Gen 46:2-7 - all people move to Egypt (70 in all) Ex 12:40-41 - 430 years (30 as free years, 400 as slaves) Ex 24:3-8 - they entered into a covenant (Covenant of Law - Old Covenant)</p> | <p>the law was added until the promised seed had come</p> <p>Scripture shut up everyone under sin (Points out your sin - shows how helpless we are to be righteous)</p> <p>the promise was that there was one coming - through faith in Jesus Christ - we have power over sin - we are imputed His righteousness</p> <p>God revealed the promised in His proper time</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - we have to have faith in order to receive the promise - faith needs to be revealed - we are justified by faith - now that faith has come we are no longer under the tutor (law) - we are sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus |
