<p>Gen 17 - call for circumcision - obeyed immediately</p> <p>Gen 22:1-19 (He 11:17-19) - Abraham was willing to give his only son knowing that God could bring him back from the dead</p> <p>Undying trust that whatever happened - God was in complete control!</p>	<p>Ex 4:18-26 Did not wholeheartedly keep the covenant of the Lord - not important?</p> <p>God sought to put him to death</p> <p>God demands to be honored, obeyed, respected, treated as holy</p> <p>James 3:1 - when God deals with people, He deals more severely with those who are leaders</p> <p>God doesn't want a leader who doesn't obey Him completely</p> <p>Num 20:12 (Moses did not treat God as holy) - Dt 32:51-52</p>	<p>They exchanged robes, weapons, and belt</p> <p>Jonathan stands up against his father, Saul</p> <p>Covenant bond is stronger than family ties</p> <p>Covenant includes the descendants I Sam 16, 18-20, 22, 24, 26, 27:1-4</p> <p>David honored Saul and Saul's position</p> <p>David promised to protect Jonathan's family</p> <p>I Sam 31 II Sam 1; 2:1-11; 4:1-12; 5:1-5, 9-12; 9</p> <p>Mephibosheth was Jonathan's son - David showed him lovingkindness</p> <p>David honored and kept his covenant promise</p>	<p>Abrahamic covenant (promise)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - great nation - land - blessings would come from him - an everlasting covenant <p>Covenant of Law (Old)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Picture (plyometric box) - God was going to teach them their shortcomings <p>Covenant of Grace (New)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - fulfillment - God was going to show them the solution
