God sought to put him to death God demands to be honored, obeyed, respected, treated as holy  James 3:1 - when God deals with people, He deals more severely with those who are leaders  God doesn't want a leader who doesn't obey Him completely  Num 20:12 (Moses did not treat God as holy) - Dt 32:51-52	They exchanged robes, weapons, and belt  Jonathan stands up against his father, Saul  Covenant bond is stronger than family ties  Covenant includes the descendants I Sam 16, 18-20, 22, 24, 26, 27:1-4  David honored Saul and Saul's position  David promised to protect Jonathan's family I Sam 31 II Sam 1; 2:1-11; 4:1-12; 5:1-5, 9-12; 9  Mephibosheth was Jonathan's son - David showed him lovingkindness  David honored and kept his covenant promise	Abrahamic covenant (promise) - great nation - land - blessings would come from him - an everlasting covenant  Covenant of Law (Old) - Picture (plyometric box) - God was going to teach them their shortcomings  Covenant of Grace (New) - fulfillment - God was going to show them the solution
