Our very nature is sin - not at a certain age - Ps 51:2-5 - our very seed is contaminated with sin - Ps 53:1-3 (Mk 10:18) - none seek after God - God alone is good - Eph 2:1-3 - by nature we are children of wrath - Ro 6:23 - wages of sin is death - Ro 5:12-14 - sin existed before the Law - death comes to everyone - even if they don't know the law - Ro 2:11-12 - ignorance of the Law doesn't save us from judgment	Ro 3:10-11 - none righteous Ro 8:6-8 - the nature of man is not even able to subject itself to God Ro 9:14-24 - Potter has the right over the clay to do whatever He wills I Cor 2:14 - natural man doesn't accept things of God (Jn 10:24-27 - can't hear His voice)  How can we be saved?
