<p>1:1-17</p> <p>Bond-servant - willing slave (1)</p> <p>Called as an apostle (1)</p> <p>Set apart for the gospel of God (1) - sanctification</p> <p>Promised beforehand through His prophets (2)</p> <p>Born a descendant of David according to the flesh (human) (3)</p> <p>Declared the Son of God (4)</p> <p>Power of the resurrection (4) - according to the Spirit of holiness</p> <p>Jesus Christ our Lord - Christ's deity</p> <p>Received grace and apostleship to bring obedience of faith (5)</p> <p>Grace and peace - through God (7)</p> <p>Faith is proclaimed throughout the whole world (8)</p> <p>Serve God through the preaching of the Gospel(9)</p> <p>Longs to impart some spiritual gift so they can be established (11)</p> <p>Encouraged together about each other's faith (12)</p> <p>Eager to share the gospel (15)</p> <p>Not ashamed of the Gospel (16)</p> <p>The gospel is the power of God for salvation for everyone who believes (16)</p> <p>God is revealed from faith to faith (17)</p> <p>Righteous man shall live by faith (17)</p>	<p>Wrath of God is revealed against all unrighteousness (18)</p> <p>Men suppress the truth in unrighteousness (18)</p> <p>Truth about God that man knows - conscience (19)</p> <p>God's power has been clearly seen and known - man is without excuse (20)</p> <p>Man knew God but did not honor or give thanks(21)</p> <p>They became helpless, and hearts were darkened (21)</p> <p>They became fools (22)</p> <p>They gave up giving honor to God to give honor to things - idols (23)</p> <p>God gives them over to their lusts (24)</p> <p>Exchanged truth for a lie (25)</p> <p>Served the creature rather than the Creator (25)</p> <p>God gave them over to their lusts - homosexuality (26-27)</p> <p>Filled with</p> <p>Unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil, full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice, gossips, slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful, (29-31)</p>
