Was Abraham justified by works of the flesh? (1-2)  What does Scripture say? - Abraham believed God  It was reckoned to him as righteousness One who works - wage not reckoned favor, but what was due (4) One who does not work but believes Faith is reckoned as righteousness (5) Blessed is the man God reckons righteous apart from works (6) Blessed is the man whose lawless deeds are forgiven, whose sins are covered, whose sins the Lord will not take into account (7,8)  NOT RECKONED RIGHTEOUS BECAUSE OF WORKS	Is the blessing on circumcised or the uncircumcised also? (9) Faith was credited to Abraham as righteousness (9)  How reckoned? While circumcised? (10)  While not circumcised (10)  Received the sign of circumcision a seal of the righteousness of faith while uncircumcised (11)  He would become the father of all who believe without being circumcised - righteousness may be credited to them (11)  That he might be the father of the circumcision who follow the faith of Abraham when he was uncircumcised (12)  NOT RECKONED RIGHTEOUS BECAUSE OF CIRCUMCISION	Promise to Abraham not through the Law, by through righteous of faith (13)  If those of the Law are heirs - faith made void, promise nullified (14)  Law brings wrath Where there is not Law no violation (15)  By faith the promise is to all the descendants - not only to those of the Law but also those of faith of Abraham - the father of us all (16)  NOT RECKONED RIGHTEOUS BECAUSE OF THE LAW	Abraham believed God who gives life to the dead & calls into being that which doesn't exist (17b)  In hope against hope he believed that he might be the father of many nations (18)  Without being weak in faith he contemplated his own body and Sarah's - as good as dead (19)  With respect to the promise - he did not waver in unbelief, but grew strong in faith giving glory to God (20)  He was fully assured that what God promised, He wold perform (21)  Therefore it was credited to him as righteousness (22)  RECKONED RIGHTEOUS BECAUSE OF FAITH	Not only for his sake was it reckoned (23)  For our sake it will be reckoned as those who believe in God who raised Jesus from the dead. (24)  Jesus was delivered for our transgression - was raised for our justification (25)  ALL WHO BELIEVE WILL BE RECKONED RIGHTEOUS
