<p>Japheth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tarshish, Magog, Kittim - cities - Gomer - name - Settles the coastlines (5) - nations, language, families (5) - separated <p>Ham - cursed</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Seba, Raamah, Canaan (6-7) - Nimrod (rebel or rebellion) (8) - Mighty one on the earth - Mighty hunter (9) - His kingdoms - Babel, Erech, Accad - plains of Shinar (10) - Assyrians - Nineveh (11) - Casluhim- father of the Philistines (13) <p>Canaan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - all the "ites" (15-18) - Canaan spread abroad as far as Sodom and Gomorrah (18-19) - nations, language, families (20) <p>Shem</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Peleg - in his days the earth was divided - Division after the tower of Babel ? - Division of the land masses? - nations, language, families (31) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - earth used the same language (1) - They were journeying - settled in the land of Shinar (2) - Made bricks (3) - Build a city with a tower whose top will reach into heaven (4) - Make a name for themselves - pride (4) - They didn't want to scatter (defiance to God's commands) (4) - They attempted to take God's glory and apply it to themselves - God saw what man was doing (5) - Working together - nothing will be impossible for them (6) - God confused their languages so they didn't understand each other (7) - God scattered them (8) 	<p>Before flood - men lived 900+ yrs</p> <p>Shem - 600 (10-11)</p> <p>Arpachshad - born 2 yrs after flood - 438 (12-13)</p> <p>Shelah - 433 (14-15)</p> <p>Eber - 464 (16-17)</p> <p>Peleg - 239 (18-19)</p> <p>Reu - 239 (20-21)</p> <p>Serug - 230 (22-23)</p> <p>Nahor - 148 (24-25)</p> <p>Terah - 205 (26-32)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Abram, Nahor, Haran - Haran's son - Lot - Lived in Ur of Chaldeans - Abram, Sarai, and Lot go with Terah headed to Canaan - Settled in Haran - Terah died in Haran <p>Abram married Sarai - Sarai was barren</p>
