<p>Mt 7:1-6 - this passage doesn't say don't judge - be careful to examine our lives first - make sure we go to our brother with right motives and a right heart</p> <p>Gal 6:1</p> <p>Titus 3:10-11</p> <p>I Tim 5:20</p> <p>James 5:19-20</p> <p>Luke 17:3-4</p>	<p>Matt 18:15-17</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to him in private 2. Take 2 or 3 with you 3. Take it to the church <p>The intent is not to air dirty laundry to everyone</p> <p>Intent is to address those who are living in sin and refusing to repent</p> <p>Goal - get them to repent</p> <p>Treat them like a Gentile or tax collector - put them out of the fellowship</p>	<p>I Cor 5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sin immorality - The church has become arrogant and not mourned - Put them out of the church - remove them from the midst - Little leaven leavens the whole lump <p>Successful conclusion</p> <p>II Cor 2:5-11 - he had sorrow and repented - bring him back and love him and forgive him</p> <p>II Cor 7:8-12 - Godly sorrow - leads to repentance</p>	<p>I Tim 5:20 - brings a fear to other people</p> <p>Purging of the church</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sin has no place in God's kingdom on earth - There is not place for sin in heaven either (Mt 22:13; 25:30; I Cor 6:9-10; Rev 22:15; Gal 5:19-21; Eph 5:5)
