Romans 9:30-33	Romans 10:1-13	Romans 10:14-21
<p>Gentiles attained righteousness by <u>faith</u> (30)</p> <p>Israel pursued righteousness by works - stumbling over the stumbling stone (32)</p> <p>He who <u>believes</u> in Him will not be disappointed (33)</p> <p>How saved? by faith and not by works</p>	<p>Israel had a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge (2)</p> <p>not knowing about God's righteousness sought to establish their own righteousness</p> <p>they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God (3)</p> <p>Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes (4)</p> <p>Christ is the goal</p> <p>God orchestrated our salvation (6-7)</p> <p>confess Jesus as Lord (Master) & Believe that God raised Him from the dead (9) = saved</p> <p>belief results in righteousness (10)</p> <p>with mouth confession leads to salvation</p> <p>whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved (13)</p>	<p>Process (14-15)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. someone is sent to preach 2. then they will hear 3. then they can believe <p>all did not heed/believe (16)</p> <p>faith comes by hearing the Word of Christ (17)</p> <p>have they all heard - Yes (18)</p> <p>Israel knew! (19)</p> <p>Lord prophesied that the Gentiles would respond, make Israel jealous (19-20)</p> <p>Israel was disobedient and obstinate - BUT God is merciful (21)</p>
