

## Ezekiel 8-11 - Lesson 3

Abominations in Temple - 8	God Calls Executioners - 9	God's Glory Departs - 10
<p>6th year, 5th day, 6th month</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Brought in vision to Jerusalem</li> <li>- Idol of jealousy sitting right inside the North Gate - in the inner court (3)</li> <li>- Glory of God is still in the temple (4)</li> <li>- Judgment, purifying, radiance of God (2)</li> <li>- The people had driven God out of His sanctuary (5-6)</li> <li>- Inside the temple there are idols carved into the walls (12)</li> <li>- God doesn't see us (so they think!)</li> <li>- Women were outside the gate weeping for Tammuz (14-15) - idol that represents fertility - women were crying waiting for their god to return</li> <li>- They were worshipping the sun god</li> <li>- 25 - could represent 24 orders of priests plus the high priests = all of the priests? (16-17)</li> <li>- God will deal in wrath, He will have no pity on them (18)</li> </ul>	<p>Continuation from 8</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 6 men came from the north (2) - shattering weapon</li> <li>- Standing next to bronze altar</li> <li>- A man clothed in linen</li> <li>- Glory of God moves to threshold (3)</li> <li>- Executioners going out to destroy all who don't have a mark on them (those who groaned at the abominations had a mark) - starting with the elders (5-7)</li> <li>- Are you going to kill the whole remnant (8)</li> <li>- God will have no pity! (9-10)</li> <li>- The man in linen has completed his task (11)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God's throne is seen above the cherubim</li> <li>- Man in linen is to take coals from between the wheels and scatter them on Jerusalem (Jerusalem will burn) - (1-2)</li> <li>- Glory of the Lord left the cherubim and was on the threshold (3-4)</li> <li>- Glory of the Lord departs from the temple (18)</li> </ul> <p>Rev 3:20 - Jesus is standing at the church's door and knocking - He wants in</p>

Evil Rulers to be judged - 11	Glory of the Lord
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 25 men - leaders of their people, they are men who devise iniquity and give evil advice (1)</li> <li>- Whatever they advised filled the streets with the slain (6)</li> <li>- You have feared the sword, I will bring the sword upon you (8)</li> <li>- Jer 27:9-17 - they are told to go peacefully and serve Babylon</li> <li>- Trust their weapons, their city, their strength, their prophets - everything except God</li> <li>- In the midst of judgment God promises that He will gather His people (14-21) - something has to change - their heart (Jer 31:31-34) - the New Covenant</li> <li>- God's glory leaves the city and goes out to the mountain - His glory depart (22-25)</li> </ul>	<p>The glory of the Lord - described as the radiance of the Lord - shining</p> <p><b><u>I Sam 4:21-22 - Ichabod - the glory of the Lord departed</u></b></p> <p><b><u>I Sam 10:18-19 - rejected your God</u></b>, who delivers you from all your calamities and your distresses; yet <b><u>you have said, 'No, but set a king over us!'</u></b></p> <p><b><u>II Chron 6:1-2; 7:1-3 - 6:1 He would dwell in the thick cloud. 7:1 the glory of the Lord filled the house.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Ez 1:26-28. 27 there was a radiance around Him. 28 likeness of the glory of the Lord.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Ez 8:3-4 - behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, like the appearance</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Ez 9:3 - the glory of the God of Israel went up from the cherub . . . to the threshold of the temple.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Ez 10:3-4 - cloud filled the inner court . . . the glory of the Lord went up from the cherub to the threshold of the temple . . . court was filled with the brightness of the glory of the Lord.</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b><u>Ex 40:17, 34-35 - cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.</u></b></li> </ul> <p><b><u>Ez 10:18-20 - Then the glory of the Lord departed from the threshold of the temple</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Ez 11:22-23 - The glory of the Lord went up from the midst of the city and stood over the mountain which is east of the city.</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Lk 2:21-32 - And the glory of Your people Israel."</u></b></p> <p><b><u>John 1:1. 14. 1 the Word was God. 14 dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, the only begotten from the Father</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Heb 1:1, 3. 2 spoken to us in His Son, 3 He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature,</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Mt 23:37-39 38 your house is being left to you desolate!</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Rev 1:12-18 16 His face was like the sun shining in its strength</u></b></p>
