<p>1-4</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- remember God's leading for 40 years</li> <li>- Humbling them, testing them - would they obey</li> </ul> <p>5-10</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- disciplining them</li> <li>- correcting their attitude before they came into the land</li> <li>- Good land - food</li> <li>- Iron and copper</li> </ul> <p>11-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- don't forget God</li> <li>- Self-sufficiency makes it easy to forget God</li> <li>- Pride - root of forgetfulness</li> <li>- God gave you the power to make the wealth</li> <li>- IF YOU EVER FORGET - you will perish</li> </ul>	<p>1-3 - God is going before you as a consuming fire</p> <p>4-5 - it is not for your righteousness but for their wickedness that I am giving you this land</p> <p>6-14 - they are stubborn and rebellious - remember the tablets of stone and their idol</p> <p>15-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moses pleading on behalf of the people</li> <li>- Rehearsing God's promises</li> <li>- Remembering how God's power would be seen by the nations</li> <li>- Provoking the Lord (22-24)</li> </ul> <p>Taberah (Num 11:1-3) - "burning"</p> <p>Massah (Ex 17:1-7) - "testing"</p> <p>Kibroth-hattaavah (Nu 11:31-35) - "graves of craving"</p>	<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Moses makes 2 tablets and God writes His commands again</li> <li>- They were put in the ark of the covenant</li> </ul> <p>6-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Levi is chosen as God's servants</li> <li>- They have no inheritance in the land</li> </ul> <p>10-11 - Moses beseeches God not to destroy Israel</p> <p>12-22</p> <p>What does God want?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- fear the Lord, walk in His ways, love Him, serve Him, keep His commandments</li> <li>- Circumcise your heart, cling to God</li> </ul> <p>Attributes of God</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God of heaven and earth, love of God, great and mighty, awesome</li> <li>- God of gods, Lord of lords</li> <li>- Executes justice</li> <li>- He is your praise</li> </ul>	<p>1-7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- love and obey</li> <li>- You have seen God's power</li> <li>- Examples of those who rebel and don't keep God's commands - Dathan and Abiram (rebellion of Korah - Num 16)</li> </ul> <p>8-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- keep the commands and you will be strong in the land</li> <li>- Description of land compared to Egypt</li> <li>- God provides the rains in this good land</li> </ul> <p>13-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- blessed with rain when you obey</li> <li>- God's anger will be kindled when you serve other gods</li> </ul> <p>18-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- impress these words on your hearts</li> <li>- Impress them on the children</li> </ul> <p>26-32 - blessing and a curse - be careful</p>	<p>1-7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- utterly destroy everything that has to do with pagan worship</li> <li>- Don't mix their religions with your relationship with God</li> <li>- Bring their contributions to God - where He chooses</li> </ul> <p>8-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- don't be doing right in your eyes</li> <li>- Do what is right in God's eyes</li> <li>- They need to bring their offerings where God chooses</li> </ul> <p>15-28</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- different rules for eating meat for you family versus putting aside animals for offerings</li> <li>- Offerings are only made where God shows you</li> </ul> <p>29-32</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- whatever God commands - do - don't add or take away</li> </ul>
