<p>Persecution -#1375 - diogmos - to pursue to persecute</p> <p>Afflictions - #2347 - thlipsis - to break, crush, compress, squeeze - pressure or burden on the spirit</p> <p>Suffer - #3958 - pascho - to experience something evil - mostly suffering on behalf of someone else</p> <p>We suffer because . . .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- our sin</li> <li>- Of other people's sin</li> <li>- Opportunity to learn and grow</li> <li>- God is using us to teach others about Him</li> <li>- Satan is throwing his fiery darts at you</li> <li>- Kingdom of God - we are hated because they hated Jesus first (Mt 5:10-12; 10:16-25; Jn 15:16-25; 17:14-18)</li> <li>- Name of Jesus brings division (Mt:10-34-40)</li> </ul>	<p>II Tim 3:10-13 - all who desire to live godly will be persecuted</p> <p>John 16:33 - the world has tribulation - He has peace - He has overcome the world</p> <p>Phil 1:29-30 - granted the privilege of suffering with Christ</p> <p>Acts 5:41 - rejoiced that they were considered worthy to suffer shame for Christ</p> <p>Jn 15:20 - a slave is not greater than his master - the persecuted Jesus they will persecute us</p>	<p>II Thes 1:5 - worthy of the kingdom of God</p> <p>James 1:2-4 - the trials brings perseverance and perfects (completes) us (mature in our faith)</p> <p>I Pet 1:6-9 - prove our faith, test us by fire so we can bring praise, glory, and honor to Him</p> <p>I Pet 4:12-19 - the degree we suffer the degree we rejoice with His coming</p> <p>I Pet 5:8-11 - God will perfect, confirm, strengthen, and establish you</p> <p>He 5:7-9 - we learn obedience through suffering</p>
