Bride for Isaac (24)	Isaac's Sons (25:19-34)	Settling in Gerar (26)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- oldest, most trusted servant and charged him with task of finding a wife for Isaac (2-3) - Gen 15:2? - Eliezer?</li> <li>- Didn't want a wife from the Canaanites - go back to my family (3-4)</li> <li>- If the woman won't come - you are free from your vow (5-9)</li> <li>- Goes to Mesopotamia and Nahor (10)</li> <li>- Looking for the response of drink and I will water your camels (11-14)</li> <li>- God led the servant to Rebekah - he worships the Lord for answering his prayer</li> <li>- Rebekah responded positively and was willing to immediately go with the servant</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Isaac was 40 when he married Rebekah (20)</li> <li>- After 19 years - she was barren and Isaac prayed for her (21)</li> <li>- Rebekah conceived twins - struggled in her womb (22-23)</li> <li>- God said there were 2 nations in her womb - the older would serve the younger</li> <li>- Esau - "red" - hairy all over</li> <li>- Jacob - "supplanter" (supersede another especially by force or treachery) - (24-26)</li> <li>- Isaac loves Esau - skillful hunter, and man of the field, Isaac loves game (27)</li> <li>- Rebekah loves Jacob - peaceful man (28)</li> <li>- Jacob forces Esau to choose between satisfying his fleshly desire (eat!) or holding on to his legacy (29-32)</li> <li>- Esau despised his birthright (34)</li> </ul> <p>He 12:14-17            Ro 9:1-16 - God has made choices and His purpose stands! There is no injustice with God! (Ro 1:18-end)            (Num 14)</p>
