<p>Ammon and Moab</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Gen 19:29-38</li> <li>- I King 11:7</li> </ul> <p>Ammon (1-7)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- they cheered when Judah was made desolate</li> <li>- They will be given as spoils to the nations (from the east - Babylon)</li> </ul> <p>Moab (8-11)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Israel has no protection - they are like everyone else</li> <li>- They will be remembered no more</li> </ul> <p>Edom (12-14)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Gen 32:3 - Esau = Edom</li> <li>- Took vengeance against Judah</li> <li>- God will use His people to bring His wrath on Edom - cut off man and beast</li> </ul> <p>Philistines (15-17)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Gen 10:14, 13, 6, 1</li> <li>- Noah-Ham-Mizraim-Casluhim (Philistines)</li> <li>- Ex 13:17 - enemies from founding of nation</li> <li>- Judges 13-16 (13:1) - God gave Israel to them for 40 years</li> </ul>	<p>586 BC - the fall of Jerusalem</p> <p>1-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tyre was taking advantage of Israel when she was laid waste</li> <li>- Tyre will become spoils for the nations</li> </ul> <p>7-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Neb and Babylon will over run them</li> <li>- It will be laid bare - all the spoil will taken</li> </ul> <p>15-18</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- coastlands will groan at her slaughter</li> <li>- The nations around them will be terrified when it falls</li> </ul> <p>19-21</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- she will be sent to the pit</li> <li>- Will not be found anymore</li> </ul>	<p>1-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- merchant to the peoples of many coastlands</li> <li>- She is a magnificent ship that sailed the seas and all men dealt in her merchandise</li> </ul> <p>10-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- all the nations wanted to be part of them</li> </ul> <p>12-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- they had every kind of wealth</li> <li>- Traded in the heart of the sea</li> </ul> <p>26-36</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- overthrow of Tyre</li> <li>- Nations mourn at the loss</li> </ul> <p>Rev 18 - fall of Babylon</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- we see the same terminology as people are focused on themselves and their wealth - they mourn the loss</li> </ul>	<p>1-10 - leader of Tyre</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- lifted up because of the wealth</li> <li>- Thinks he is a god</li> <li>- Thinks he has done all this in own power</li> <li>- He will be brought down to the depths</li> </ul> <p>20-26 - Sidon</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The nations will know God when He brings judgment on them</li> <li>- Israel will know God when they see Him destroy their enemies</li> </ul>

<p>Ez 28:11-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- perfect in wisdom and beauty (12)</li> <li>- Created being (13)</li> <li>- Anointed covering cherub (14)</li> <li>- Blameless until unrighteousness was found in him (15)</li> <li>- Proudful (17)</li> <li>- Multitude of sins (18)</li> </ul> <p>Is 14:12-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I will ascend into heaven</li> <li>- I will be over all the angels</li> <li>- I will sit on the mount of assembly</li> <li>- I will ascend above the clouds</li> <li>- I will be like God</li> </ul> <p>Gen 3:1-5 (I John 2:15-17; James 1:14)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- you can be like God</li> <li>- God is withholding what is good from you</li> </ul> <p>We are driven by self (lust, desire)</p>	<p>Jn 8:44 - murderer and the father of lies</p> <p>Jn 10:7-10 - steal, lie, and destroy</p> <p>Matt 4:1-11 - tempter, twister of truth</p> <p>Matt 16:23 - wants our minds set on man's stuff and not God's</p> <p>I Cor 7:5 - tempter, exploiter</p> <p>II Cor 11:3 - deceives by craftiness</p> <p>II Thes 2:9-10 - deceitful imitator</p> <p>I Pet 5:8 - devouring roaring lion</p> <p>I John 3:8 - sinner</p> <p>Rev 12:10 (Zech 3:1-2; Job 1:6-12) - accuser of the brethren</p>	<p>Is 14:12 - weakens the nations</p> <p>Jn 12:31; 14:30; 16:11 - ruler of this world</p> <p>Eph 2:1-2 - working in the sons of disobedience</p> <p>Eph 6:12 - battling rulers, powers, world forces of darkness, spiritual forces of wickedness</p> <p>Matt 4:8-11 - ruler over the realm of mankind</p> <p>I Jn 5:19 - world lies in the power of the evil one</p> <p>James 4:4 - friendship with the world makes us an enemy of God</p>	<p>James 4:7 - submit to God, resist the devil, and he will flee</p> <p>I Peter 5:9 - resist him by being firm in our faith</p> <p>II Cor 2:9-11 - Satan will take advantage of us when there is no forgiveness in our hearts - don't be ignorant of his schemes</p> <p>Eph 6:11-17 - put on the full armor of God, stand firm!</p>	<p>I John 3:8 - Jesus destroyed the works of the devil</p> <p>Rom 16:20 - he will be crushed under our feet</p> <p>Gen 3:15 - his head will be crushed by Jesus Christ</p> <p>Matt 25:41 - the eternal fire was prepared for him and his angels (demons)</p> <p>Rev 20:1-2, 7-10 - thrown in the abyss for 1,000 years, released for a short time, lake of fire</p>
