<p>Job character</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- taught many, strengthened the weak (4:3)</li> <li>- Help the stumbling stand (4:4)</li> <li>- plowing or sowing wickedness will reap judgment at some time (4:8) - Gal 6:7-9; I Pet 3:12</li> <li>- man can't be righteous enough before God (4:17-21)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- distress comes to you - your impatient (4:5)</li> <li>- It touches you and your horrified</li> <li>- Isn't your fear of God your confidence? (4:6)</li> <li>- Isn't your integrity your hope?</li> <li>- You've sown evil and trouble - now you reap it (4:8)</li> <li>- You are not holy enough (4:17-21)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- righteous will prosper and the wicked will suffer (4:7)</li> <li>- Not everything we reap in this life is something that we have sown (4:8)</li> <li>- II Cor 12:7-10 - purpose for the suffering but God's grace is sufficient</li> <li>- Jn 9:1-3</li> <li>- You are not holy enough (4:17-21)</li> </ul>
