Gilead	Psalm 107
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- balm was made from cottonwood or balsam trees- Grown where there is moisture- Make the salve out of the buds- Anti-inflammatory, antimicrobial- Pain-relieving- Wounds, joint pains, chest rub <p>Used for healing and cosmetics</p> <p>Gen 37:25 - Joseph's brothers sold him to traders</p> <p>Jer 46:11 - go to Gilead and obtain balm for your healing</p> <p>City of refuge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Jacob fled from Laban - Gen 31:21-55 (21)- Israelites fled when pursued by the Philistines (I Sam 13:5-7)- David when being pursued by Absalom (II Sam 17:22)- Moses declared it a city of refuge <p>Josh 20:1-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- it is to protect those who killed someone unintentionally- They needed to stay in the protection of the city of refuge	<p>Key phrases</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- they cried out to the Lord in their time of trouble (6, 13, 19, 28)- Let them give thanks to the Lord for His loving kindness (1, 8, 15, 21, 31, 43) <p>4-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- they were hungry and thirsty- God satisfied the hungry and thirsty soul
