Il Cor 5:1-8 - earthly body is a tent - We have an eternal building not made by hands but made by God waiting for us in the heavens - We should be longing for the home made by God - In this tent we groan - we are burdened - The mortal will be swallowed up by life - To be in this body is to be absent from the Lord - To be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord Phil 1:21-24 - to live - you live for Christ - To die - you live with Christ - We are to be fruitful - Departing is better because we can be with Christ - To remain in the flesh is necessary to accomplish the work - He has given us to do	 Christ was raised from the dead (20) In Adam all men die - in Christ all will be made alive (22) Christ is 1st fruits - those who are His will be 2nd and then the end will come (23-24) The end comes - enemies will be subjected to Christ and He will give the kingdom to His Father (25-28) What kind of body do we get? How are the dead raised? Life comes out of the death of the seed being buried (36-37) We will be given a heavenly body as He wishes (38-41) Sown one way - raised another Perishable - imperishable (42) Dishonor - glory (43) Weakness - power (43) Natural -spiritual (44) image of earthy - image of the heavenly (49) Flesh and blood can't inherit the kingdom of God (50) Death is swallowed in victory (54) BE STEADFAST, IMMOVABLE, ABOUNDING in the work of the Lord (58) Rom 4:21

- the fact that they would be with Christ at His coming - they remained faithful to the end I Thes 3:13	
 their hearts be established (Act 14:21-22; 16:5; Ro 1:11-12; I Pet 5:10; II Pet 1:12) Blameless = free from all valid charges against you which means that we have dealt with our sin in our lives and stand in holiness before God (II Cor 7:1) 	I Thes 4:13-18; I Thes 5:2-11; I Cor 15:51-52 - don't be uninformed (4:13) - Don't grieve like those who have no hope (4:13) - This is good news for those who believe in Jesus (4:14) - Not of the darkness - we are sons of light/day - be alert and sober and prepared (5:4, 6, 8) - Comfort each other (4:18) - Encourage one another and build one another up (5:11) God has not destined us to wrath by obtaining salvation through Christ (5:9; I Thes 1:10; Rev 3:10)
