Take the log out first - first need to examine our life Our life needs to be right before the Lord before we can help someone else (Matt 7:1-5) Standard of measure needs to be the same for us and others - God's Word Right relationship with God (spiritual) - go in gentleness - realizing our weakness and how we too can fall (Gal 6:1) We are not to be judging instead of loving (love is the fulfillment of the Law) James 4:11-12 (John13:35 - we are to be known for our love) Judging without love shows that we are judging by our standards not God's	Judge that someone is straying from the truth - with God's Word - turn them back (James 5:19-20) Are people putting confidence in the flesh (Phil 3:2-3) Watch and discern the way people walk (Phil 3:17-19) Where is the mind set (Phil 3:17-19) Between the spirit of truth and the spirit of error (I John 4:1-6) Those who live unruly lifestyles, doing no work, acting as busybodies (II Thes 3: 6, 11, 14-15) Judge ourselves - see whether we eat and drink in a worthy manner (I Cor 11:27-32)	Hypocrisy - you're guilty of the same thing only worse while telling someone else they are in sin - judgmental (Matt 7:1-5) We think so highly of our ability to correct people - but we do the same thing ourselves (Ro 2:1-6, 17-24) Whenever I judge and start with, "I think", I am now judging opinions - DON'T (Ro 14:1-15:1)
