<p>Paul's sorrow over Israel's rejection</p> <p>Israelites - to whom belong</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - adoption as sons - glory - covenants - Giving of the Law - temple service - promises <p>This Christ came from you - and you rejected Him</p>	<p>The Word of God has not failed (6)</p> <p>In Scripture</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God's choice is not by natural descendants - true children are children of promise - election is supernatural, sovereign choice of God and it wasn't based on works <p>God's choice was so that God's purpose would stand (11)</p> <p>In God's purpose an election is made = the way has always been God's choice</p> <p>Jacob I loved, Esau I hated (#3404) - love less, to defeat (rejected)</p>	<p>Is there injustice with God? No! (14)</p> <p>God has mercy on whom He chooses (15)</p> <p>mercy is based on God's sovereign will (16)</p> <p>God raised up Pharaoh to show His power (17)</p> <p>God has mercy on some, and hardens others (18)</p> <p>God showed: mercy to Israel justice to Pharaoh</p>	<p>Why does He still find fault? Who resists His will? Who are you to think that you can question God? (20)</p> <p>the potter has the right over the clay (21) God determines how the clay will be used</p> <p>vessels of wrath = prepared for destruction (prepared = fitted) *vessel prepared itself for destruction</p> <p>vessels of mercy = prepared for glory (22-23)</p> <p>active and passive voice active the subject does the action Passive something is done to the subject</p>	<p>Gentiles attained righteousness by pursuing faith</p> <p>Israel missed righteousness because they were pursuing it by works</p> <p>they stumbled over the very one who came to save them</p>
