Chapter 32	Chapter 33
<p>Aaron is approached to make a god - golden calf (1-6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - god to go before them - Under pressure - they were quick to turn to other gods - Young bull - religious fertility symbol in both Egypt and Canaan - This action broke the first 3 commandments - Aaron collects gold, fashioned the calf, built an altar, proclaimed a feast - sacrifices were brought - Blending pagan rituals with God worship - syncretism <p>God's anger (7-10)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - YOUR people have corrupted themselves <p>God Relents (11-14)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses pleads with God - turn from Your anger - What will Egypt say - Moses's focus was on God's glory - Reminds God of the promise made to Abraham - Moses's commitment was tested <p>Moses comes with the two tablets (15-18)</p> <p>Moses threw the tablets and shattered them - just as the people had shattered God's commands (19-20)</p> <p>Aaron is held responsible (21-24)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - what did the people do to you? - You know the people - "I didn't make this - it just happened" <p>God deals with the sin (25-29)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - decision was made as to who would stand for the Lord - 3,000 were killed - judgment on sin <p>Moses confronts sin - atonement needs to be made (30-35)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ro 9:1-3 	<p>1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God is going to keep keep His promise - of the land and driving out the inhabitants - God would not go up in their midst - They obstinate - He may destroy them is He is among them <p>4-6</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sadness - mourning - They know they have sinned against Almighty God - Stripped themselves of their ornaments <p>7-11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses pitched a tent outside the camp - tent of meeting - If anyone wanted to inquire of the Lord, they went to the tent - Pillar of cloud would descend there - Moses would meet face to face with God <p>12-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses tells God that these are His people - Asks God to go in their presence - it is the only thing that distinguishes from everyone else (nations) <p>17-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses's desire is to see God and His glory - God puts Him in the cleft of the rock and covers Moses with God's hand as He passes by - Moses will see God's back

<p>1-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Moses cuts out 2 tablets and meets God on the top of the mountain - Moses is calling on the name of the Lord - when He appears Moses makes haste bows low and worships - Compassionate and gracious - Slow to anger - abounding in lovingkindness and truth - Forgives iniquity, transgression, and sin - He will not leave the guilty unpunished <p>10-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Covenant keeping God - God was going to work miracles among His people - Observe what God is commanding them - don't make covenant with the people of the land - it will be a snare to you - Tear down the worship areas - God is a jealous God - Make no molten gods <p>18-26</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observation of the Feast of Passover/Unleavened Bread - Redeeming of the firstborn (these died in Egypt) - Celebrate the Feast of Weeks/Feast of Ingathering - 3 times all the males come before God - Sabbath and first fruits of crops <p>27-35</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God enters into a covenant with the people - Moses's face shone with the glory of being in the presence of God (II Cor 3:7-18) 	<p>2-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 6 days you work - the 7th you rest - Violation is punishable by death - Don't kindle a fire in their homes <p>4-9</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bringing a contribution - Whoever is of willing heart <p>10- 19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - skillful men were to come to make what the Lord commanded <p>20-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - those whose hearts stirred them brought all that they had - There were those who helped in anyway they could <p>30-35</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - calling and gifting of Bezalel and Oholiab - God put it in their hearts to be able to teach
