<p>TAKE OFF</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - malice #G2549 - malignity, ill-will, desire to injure, depravity - Deceit #G1388 - crafty, guile (to decoy), a lure, snare - Hypocrisy #G5272 - acting of a stage player - Envy #G5355 - jealousy, spite, feeling of displeasure by witnessing the advantage or prosperity of others - Slander #G2636 - evil speakings, defamation, backbiting <p>PUT ON</p> <p>Long for the pure milk of the word</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - like newborn babies - Grow (passive, aorist) in respect to your salvation - IF you have tasted the grace of the Lord 	<p>Matt 16:13-20</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You are the Christ the Son of the living God - God revealed this to Peter - You are Peter (Petros - #G4074) - stone, little rock - Upon this Rock (Petra - #G4073) - rock, cliff, large - I will build my church on this Petra (big rock???) - The gates of Hades will not prevail over it - Keys to the kingdom given - Whatever bound on earth or loosed on earth shall have been bound/loosed in heaven - Mt 18:15-20 - it is addressing someone and calling sin sin - Jn 20:19-23 - acting on behalf of Jesus - Lk 10:17-20 - they have Jesus' power to accomplish His plan on earth - Eph 1:18-23 - all things are subjected to Christ - they are under the church's authority <p>Keys - show power and authority (Is 22:22; Rev 3:7) - power to open, power to shut</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lk 11:52 - took away the keys of knowledge - Rev 1:18 - keys to death and Hades - Rev 9:1; 20:1 - keys to the abyss 	<p>Jesus was the living - rejected by people, choice and precious in the sight of God (4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - laid in Zion as a choice stone (6) - Precious cornerstone - Believe in Him - not be put to shame - Precious value to those who believe (7) - Unbelieving stumble over Him because of disobedience to the Word (8) - Lk 2:34 - He was appointed for the fall and rise of many - He was a sign to be opposed <p>You also are living stones (5)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - being built up as a spiritual house - Holy priesthood to offer up spiritual sacrifices <p>Eph 2:11-22 (19-22)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - fellow citizens in God's household - Foundation of apostles and prophets - Cornerstone - Jesus - We are being fitted together - growing into the holy temple of the Lord - Into a dwelling of God in the Spirit <p>I Cor 3:16-17 - temple of God - Spirit dwells in you - you are holy</p> <p>I Cor 6:19-20 - temple of the Holy Spirit - we are not our own - bought with a price - glorify God with our body</p> <p>I Tim 3:15 - church is the household of God - the pillar and support of the truth</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Chosen race - Royal priesthood - Holy nation - People of God' own possession - Proclaim His excellencies - He called us out of darkness into light - Once we were not a people and didn't receive mercy (10) - Now we are God's people and have received mercy <p>As Foreigners and Strangers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - abstain from fleshly lusts - wage war with our soul (11) - Keep our behavior excellent among the Gentiles (12) - Because of our good deeds - they glorify God <p>Acting as Priesthood</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ro 12:1-2 - living sacrifice - Ro 15:15-16 - priest of the gospel of God - Rev 1:5-6 (Rev 5:9-10; 20:6) - made into a kingdom of priests <p>Offering up Sacrifices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ps 50:14 (107:22) - thanksgiving - Ps 51:17 - broken spirit and contrite heart - Phil 4:17-19 - our giving an acceptable sacrifice pleasing to God - He 13:15-16 - fruit of our lips - praising His name - doing good and sharing 	<p>Hupotasso #G5293 - voluntarily place oneself under, obey</p> <p>Submit to what</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - us under human authority (I Peter 2:13; Ro 13:1-7; Titus 3:1) - Servants to masters (I Peter 2:18; Titus 2:9; Eph 6:5; Col 3:22) - Wives under husbands (I Peter 3:1; Eph 5:22; Col 3:18) - Younger men under older men (I Peter 5:5) - Believers under other believers (I Cor 16:15-16) - Church under Christ (Eph 5:24) - Christ under God (Phil 2:5-11) - Younger women under older women (Titus 2:4-5) - Ourselves under God (He 12:9; James 4:7) - Children under parents (Eph 6:1; Col 3:20) <p>Submit to authority (13-17)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - for the Lord's sake - Will of God - Silence the ignorance of foolish men - Act as free people - bondservants of God <p>Masters (18-20)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - submit with all respect - Submit to those who are good and gentle - Also to the unreasonable (harsh, froward) - #G4646 - crooked, perverse, wicked, unfair, surly, tyrannical, unjust - Finds favor with God when we bear up under suffering unjustly
