Those Who Reside As Aliens	Salvation - 3 Tenses
<p>Aliens (#G3927) - resident stranger</p> <p>Scattered, dispersed (#G1290) - diaspora</p> <p>Why?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - by persecution - Acts 8:1, 4 - spread the Word as they scatter - Jn 7:35; James 1:1 - Jews being dispersed - Acts 8:1; 11:19 - church being scattered <p>Who?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Christians, believers <p>What?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - become aliens or strangers in the land - Phil 3:20 - citizenship is in heaven - He 11:9-10 - seeking a place made by God - He 11:13-16 - strangers and aliens on earth - desiring a better country, a heavenly one - I Peter 1:17 - here on this earth temporarily - conduct yourselves in fear during that time - I Peter 2:10-11 - we are a people of God - different from those who you dwell with (Eph 2:11-13) <p>WE ARE TO BE AN EXAMPLE - BE STRANGE - NOT OF THIS WORLD - LIGHTS THAT EXPOSE DARKNESS</p>	<p>Past tense - justification</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - delivered from sin's penalty - death - Saved through the atoning work of Christ on the cross - Transferred from domain of darkness to His kingdom of light - 2nd death has no power over us <p>Present tense - sanctification</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - being delivered from sin's power - Every day process of being set apart from the world - Habitual dying to self and allowing Christ to live through me - Tested, tried, and purified by the Refiner's fire - Remain faithful to the end <p>Future tense - glorification</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - shall be saved from sin's presence - Reign with Jesus - Never again be plagued with a sin nature <p>PEOPLE THINK THEY GO FROM JUSTIFICATION TO GLORIFICATION</p> <p>WE ARE MISSING THE SANCTIFICATION - THE DAILY WALK - THE EXAMPLE WE ARE TO BE AS LIGHTS</p>

<p>Sanctify = #G38 - separation (of heart and life) to God; consecrated, holiness, purified</p> <div data-bbox="121 381 651 722" data-label="Diagram"> </div> <p>II Thes 2:13; I Peter 1:1-2</p> <p>Process of Sanctification (He 10)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - (22) through faith - (10) Jesus was sacrifice once for all - (18) forgiveness of sins - (16) laws are written on our hearts - (19-20) entered into a new and living way - (14) Jesus perfects those (the process) who are being sanctified <p>I Cor 1:30 - Jesus is our wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, redemption</p> <p>Can we become holy on our own? - I Peter 1:15-16</p>	<p>Old Covenant Proclaimed (Ex 24:3-8)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - heard word of the Lord (7) - They say they will obey (7) - Sprinkled with the blood (8) - Under the covenant (8) <p>Covenant = binding agreement, promise, contract</p> <p>New Covenant Promised (Is 52:13-15)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Son lifted up and exalted (13) - Marred (suffering, trials) - Will sprinkle many nations <p>New Covenant Proclaimed (Mt 26:26-28)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Christ's blood poured out for many for forgiveness of sins <p>New Covenant Provide (He 9:13-28)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - animal blood is replaced (14) - Cleanse the conscience from dead works to serve the living God (14) - Necessity of shedding blood to bring forgiveness of sins (22) 	<p>Mt 7:21-27 - those who do the will of the Father will enter heaven</p> <p>Acts 5:28-32 - must obey God and not man - those who have the Holy Spirit obey</p> <p>Ro 1:5 - obedience of faith</p> <p>Ro 2:6-8 - obedience that brings eternal life</p> <p>Ro 6:16-19 - slaves to righteousness not to sin</p> <p>Ro 15:18 - results are obedience by word and deed</p> <p>Ro 16:25-26 - gospel leads to obedience of faith</p> <p>II Thes 1:8-9 - those who don't obey - eternal destruction</p> <p>He 5:9 - eternal salvation to those who obey</p> <p>I Peter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1:14 - obedient children - not conformed to the lusts of the world - 1:22 - Purified our souls in obedience to truth - 2:7-8 - those will stumble due to disobedience - 3:1 - our life will win over the disobedient - 3:6 - obeying is doing what is right - 3:18-20 - the disobedient are spirits locked in prison (Hades) - 4:17 - judgment of God will fall on the disobedient
