<p>Hebrews</p> <p>1 - JESUS - remember who He is and what He has done - praise, worship, calls us to obedience</p> <p>2 - don't fear death - Jesus faced it for us - need to pay attention so we don't drift away</p> <p>3 - hold fast to our confidence and boast of our hope until the end</p> <p>4 - know that the word of God judges the thoughts and intentions of our heart</p> <p>5 - learn obedience through suffering, don't become dull of hearing</p> <p>6 - press on to maturity, don't be sluggish but show diligence</p> <p>7 - Jesus is the guarantee of a better covenant, and makes intercession for us</p> <p>8 - Jesus brought better promises</p> <p>9 - Jesus is our Great High Priest - salvation through Him</p> <p>10 - Jesus' blood purifies us, we can have confidence to come into the holy</p> <p>11 - We walk in faith knowing the promise of the future</p> <p>12 - fixing our eyes on Jesus - not our circumstances!</p>	<p>Romans 12:1-2 - present our bodies as a living sacrifice - giving up what we want and allowing God to do what He wants in our life - dying to self not to be conformed (pressure from outside pushing in) but be transformed (inside out) - renewing of our mind</p> <p>Romans 6:4 (1-23) - we have died with Him so we can walk in newness of life</p> <p>II Cor 5:17 - if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature - old things have passed away and new things have come</p> <p>Eph 4:24 - put on a new self which is in the likeness of God</p> <p>Gal 3:27 - clothed ourselves with Christ</p> <p>Gal 5:22-25 - love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control</p> <p>Phil 4:4-9 - rejoice, not anxious (anxiety is the opposite trust), peace, watching what your mind dwells on</p>	<p>I Pet 2:21-24 - we need to entrust our lives to Him who judges righteously</p> <p>Matt 6:14-15 - if we forgive others, God will forgive us, if we don't forgive others, God won't forgive us</p> <p>Romans 12:14-21 - bless those who persecute you, be at peace with all men, never take revenge, reach out to enemies or to anyone - overcome evil with good</p> <p>Col 3:12-17 - bear with one another and forgive one another - let the word of Christ richly dwell in you - do all you do in the name of the Lord</p> <p>Matt 18:21-22 - there is no limit to our forgiveness</p>	<p>love of the brethren needs to continue (13:1)</p> <p>don't neglect hospitality - making people feel comfortable in your presence - people feel welcomed - sharing skills, listening skills</p> <p>hospitality</p> <p>I Peter 4:9 (I Tim 3:1-2; Titus 1:5-9) - be hospitable without complaint (grumbling)</p> <p>Rom 12:9-13</p> <p>love without hypocrisy - being devoted to one another in brotherly love - we are serving the Lord</p> <p>rejoice in hope, persevere in tribulation, devoted to prayer, caring for the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality</p> <p>I John 3:16-19 - be willing to lay down our lives for our brother - give of ourselves and our possessions as much as we can - don't love in word but in deed and truth</p> <p>I John 4:20-5:3 - we love God if we keep His commandments - if we love God, we love His children - love our brother</p> <p>Matt 22:34-40 - love God, love your neighbor</p> <p>Luke 10:25-37 - your neighbor is anyone (in need)</p> <p>I Cor 13:4-8 - demonstration of love</p>
