<p>Confess Jesus as Lord = Master - ruler of our life</p> <p>believe in our heart that God raised Him from the dead (10:9)</p> <p>believe=firm conviction, personal surrender, conduct inspired by that surrender</p> <p>whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (10:13)</p>	<p>Matt 1:21 - to save people from their sins (to miss the mark)</p> <p>I Tim 1:15 - came to save sinners</p> <p>II Cor 5:21 - He came to be made sin for you that you might become the righteousness of God in Him</p> <p>I John 3:8 - He came to destroy the works of the devil</p>	<p>Gen 3:1-7 - disobeying God - denying God's Word - setting themselves up to be their own god</p> <p>Is 53:6 - turning to our own way</p> <p>I John 3:4 - sin is lawlessness</p> <p>James 4:17 - to know the right thing to do and not do it is sin</p> <p>I Cor 6:9, 10 - sin = fornication, idolatry, adultery, homosexuality, stealing, coveting, drunkenness, reviling, swindling</p>

<p>I Cor 6:9-11 - we were like that we were washed - sanctified - justified</p> <p>Rom 6:14 - sin shall not be master over you - you are under grace</p> <p>John 8:34-36 - commit sin = slave to sin If Son sets you free = free indeed</p> <p>I John 3:9-10 No one born of God practices sin His seed abides in him He cannot sin because he is born of God God's righteousness is now in us To not love your brother is to not be of God</p>	<p>Repenting = change of mind with a change of direction</p> <p>Matt 3:1-12 bear fruit in keeping with repentance</p> <p>Mark 1:14-15 - Repent and believe</p> <p>Luke 13:2-5 - unless you repent you will perish</p> <p>Act 20:18-21 - repent & believe</p> <p>Acts 26:20 - perform deeds appropriate to repentance</p> <p>I Thes 1:5-10 turned to God (repentance) served God imitators of Paul and the Lord examples</p>	<p>Mark 10:17-31 - Jesus is to be first above possessions</p> <p>Mark 8:34-38 - denies self (put self aside)</p>
