<ul> <li>The people gathered and asked Ezra to read the Word of God (1-2)</li> <li>Long day of reading and explaining God's Word (3) - people were attentive</li> <li>14 men stood before them (agreement?) (4)</li> <li>People stand up (respect) for the reading and explanation (5)</li> <li>Lifted their hands, bowed low and worshiped (6)</li> <li>The people mourned and wept when they heard God's Word (9)</li> <li>The people were repentant</li> <li>Repentance is built solely on the hearing and understanding of God's Word</li> <li>Being confronted with truth which shatters the walls of our false securities</li> <li>Mt 28:18-20 - make disciples - by teaching them to observe what God has commanded</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>this was declared a holy day - not to mourn and weep (9)</li> <li>The joy of the Lord is your strength (10)</li> <li>They were to celebrate because they understood the Word of God (12)</li> <li>They were to celebrate the Feast of Booths</li> <li>They gathered all they needed to make the booths (13-16)</li> <li>They had not celebrated booths? - II Chron 7:8-10; Ezra 3:4 - they never celebrated with this great of rejoicing tied to it (17)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Scribe</li> <li>Priest</li> <li>He was of Aaron's line (Ez 7:1-5)</li> <li>Skilled in the law of Moses (6)</li> <li>Hand of the Lord was upon him (6)</li> <li>Went up to Jerusalem in the 7th year of Artaxerxes (7)</li> <li>It took 4 months to go from Babylon to Jerusalem (9)</li> <li>He set his heart to study the law of the Lord, to practice it, and to teach it to Israel (10)</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>24th day of the 7th month they assembled in sackcloth and fasting with dirt on them (1)</li> <li>Separated themselves from all foreigners (2)</li> <li>Ezra 10 - tried to deal with the problem</li> <li>For 6 hours they read God's Word, they confessed sin, and they worshiped God (3)</li> <li>Confession and worship</li> <li>God of creation (5-6)</li> <li>God of Moses (9-15)</li> <li>Confession time - father's acted arrogantly (16-18)</li> <li>God's great compassion (19-25)</li> <li>Confession time - disobedient and rebelled (26-27)</li> <li>God still heard them</li> <li>They did evil again (28-29)</li> <li>You had compassion on them (30-31)</li> <li>God is just (32-34)</li> <li>We are slaves because of our actions (35-37)</li> <li>We dedicate ourselves to you (38)</li> </ul>	- nation was making a new covenant with God to keep the Mosaic law - This was done in all sincerity (Ex 24:1-8) - 1-27 - list of all the signers (no Ezra) - They would marry foreigners (30) - Would not sell on the Sabbath (31) - Would bring contributions into the house of God (32-33) - Not going to neglect the house of God (34-39)  Failure was going to be sure - sin nature takes its toll
