<p>NO! (1)</p> <p>God has not rejected those people whom He foreknew (2)</p> <p>There is a remnant according to God's gracious choice (5)</p> <p>The remnant is not according to works but by God's grace (6)</p> <p>Israel sought by works but did not attain but the chosen obtained it (by faith) the rest were hardened (7)</p>	<p>Israel did not stumble so as to never get up again Israel's transgression brought salvation to the Gentiles (11) - to make the Jews jealous</p> <p>Israel's transgressions = riches for the world Israel's failure = riches for the Gentiles (12) Israel's rejection = reconciliation to the world Israel's acceptance = life from the dead (15) if 1st piece of dough is holy, the lump is if the root is holy, then the branches are (16) Branches were broken off for their unbelief (Jews) Gentiles were grafted in for their faith (17-20) Don't be arrogant Key = BELIEF</p>	<p>God's severity is toward those who fall but kindness (loving) if you continue in His love (22)</p> <p>If Israel stops their unbelief they will be grafted in again (23)</p> <p>mystery = partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in (25)</p> <p>from the standpoint of the gospel - they are enemies (28) from God's standpoint - they are beloved</p> <p>the gifts and calling of God are irrevocable (29)</p> <p>His judgments are unsearchable (33-36)</p> <p>From Him, through Him, and to Him are all things</p>
