Hebrew <u>Chata</u> - miss the mark - Sin - Ex 20:1-20 Avon - doing wrong, perverseness - Iniquity or guilt - Josh 7:20-21- I saw, coveted, I took, I hid - God will punish (Josh 22:20; Ps 89:30-34; Jer 16:10-12) Pasha - rebellion against authority - Transgression - Ps 107:11, 17 Asham - sin through error or ignorance - Trespass - Lev 5:17	Greek Hamartia - to miss the mark - Ro 14:23 - not have faith - James 4:17 - not to do the right thing - I Cor 15:56 - awareness of what we should do - James 1:15 - steps of sin - I Jn 5:17 - all unrighteousness is sin Paraptoma - turning away or turning aside from truth - becoming independent from God (trespass, transgression) Is 53:6 - our ways are better than God's ways Cost of our sin? - Is 53:4-6, 11-12 - His life - Eph 1:7 - redemption through His blood - Eph 2:5 - we were dead but He made us alive (Col 2:13)	Ez 28:12-19 - began with Satan - created angel - he was perfect - Blameless, wisdom, beauty - Unrighteousness was found in him - PRIDE Is 14:12-15 - pride Gen 2:15-17 - God said don't Gen 3:1-6 - Satan appealed to the lust of the flesh and eyes and pride Ro 5:12-19 - sin came to all mankind through one man's disobedience Ro 3:20 - sin comes through the knowledge of the law - independence from God - Running our own life - Thinking, saying, doing what we want - Being a "god" unto yourself	Gen 6:5-6 - the mind and the heart Pr 4:23 Jer 17:9-10 Matt 15:18-20 <u>Mind Games</u> Gen 3:1-7 - Crafty - Question what God says (doubt) - God lies (deny the very words of God) - Exchanged God's truth for a lie - Appeals to the pride We need the truth of God's Word to stand on in this battle

Gen 3:8-11 - brought fear, separation, and shame Breaking of His commandments Jer 16:12 - walk according to the stubbornness of our own evil heart - without listening to God Ps 107:17, 20 - fools rebel against the word of God Ro 6:1-7 - continuously walking in sin - but we are supposed to die to that	Death (Gen 2:17) - separation (spiritual, physical) - We can cause the death of others (Josh 22:20) We have been made slaves to sin - power of sin and the law over us (I Cor 15:56) Ps 107:17 - afflicted for our rebellious ways I Cor 11:17-34 - physical illness/death that come from unconfessed, unrepentant sin	Dt 30:19-20 - choose what they are going to do - choose life - Dan 1:8 Jn 5:39-40 - need to be willing to come to Him Jn 7:17-18 - need to be willing to do His will It isn't someone else's fault - IT IS OUR WRONG CHOICE OR BAD DECISION
